Dress Code Reminder

Dear Parents,

I've visited all of our classes over the past couple of weeks and am thrilled with the progress your children are making. They are ready to begin showcase choreography, and we are excited to reveal song selections in the coming week!

At this point in our 2022-23 season, the only missing piece for some of our dancers is adherence to the stated, and agreed to, uniform policy shared at the time of enrollment. So, this is just a friendly reminder that all classes have a set uniform, required for participation.

We understand there were backorders in the Fall and early Winter, but enough options are now in-stock at discountdancesupply.com, so all students should have the appropriate attire and footwear, in the correct studio colors, when they attend our classes. Similar to sports, not only does a uniform ensure our activities are distraction-free, they also allow teachers to easily help students see and understand important corrections for proper execution of movement, early childhood classes included.

Additionally, the **dress code tights and footwear are all required for participation in our May 19 Spring Showcase at NJCU**. You will want your children to get the most use out of these items for class, rather than having to purchase them for one-time use. Otherwise, **all students are expected to report to classes in proper dress code by Valentine's Day (Feb 14), without exception**, in consideration of the families who abide by the policy and expect our team to keep our word.
