Costume Fees for Spring Showcase

Costume fees vary by age/level and reflect the number of routines performed in the Spring Showcase, costume design elements, garment size, and overall production and shipping costs.

Combo classes for our youngest dancers will utilize thoughtfully coordinated costumes that can be styled for multiple routines, reducing the total cost per class enrolled while maintaining a polished stage presentation. Older students perform more technically and artistically distinct choreography, and will wear separate costumes for each routine created for them.

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COSTUME PAYMENT POLICIES

PAYMENT: Costume fees will be automatically charged to the payment method on file according to the schedule above. If a payment is declined, families will have a 72-hour grace period to update their payment information before a late fee, equal to 25% of the amount due at the time, to account for the loss of volume discounts offered by the companies providing costumes for our program.

SIZING & ALTERATIONS: Students are measured for costumes during class times throughout the month of January. After Spring Break, costumes will be distributed as they arrive, and tried on under the supervision of Teachers and/or the Program Director to ensure an appropriate fit. The studio will complete any alterations deemed necessary by staff at no additional cost to families.

EXCHANGES: Requests for a different size or fit based on personal preference (i.e., room for future growth) are subject to a \$55 rush exchange/restocking fee per garment, payable at the time of the request. Exchanges are subject to manufacturer availability and cannot be guaranteed.

SHOWCASE PARTICIPATION FEE

\$150 PER STUDENT / \$115 EACH ADDITIONAL SIBLING DUE MARCH 15, 2027

NOTE: PAW will take one group portrait of each class in costume for posterity and inclusion in the 2027 Spring Showcase Program. Portraits for families are neither included nor provided by PAW.

PAYMENT METHODS

A valid credit card must remain on file for all accounts, including those paying tuition in full, as Showcase Participation and Costume Fees are billed separately throughout the season. Cash or check may be used for installments if received by the 28th of the month preceding the installment due date.

PAYMENT TERMS

For enrollments 45+ days before the season begins, one installment ("first") is due at registration, with the next ("last") installments beginning September 1-3. For September–February enrollments, first and last installments are due at registration. Remaining installments, in either circumstance, are auto-charged between the **1st–3rd monthly**, with accounts paid in full by May 3. Returned payments incur a \$50 fee. All payments are non-refundable.

ABSENCES

No refunds are issued for planned or unplanned absences. Make-up classes are offered as a courtesy, subject to schedule availability, and must be completed within two weeks of the absence. Make-ups are not guaranteed when a student's availability does not align with the published class schedule. Courtesy make-up classes end on March 18, 2027.

WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawal requires written notice to info@performingartsworkshop-nj.com at least 30 days before the next installment due date to cancel future charges. Notice received fewer than 30 days before the next due date will incur a drop fee equal to one installment for each enrolled class.
